Enrollment

Language Arts

- We use the district-approved Language Arts curriculum like every other elementary school across the district, both Title I and non-Title I schools. All curricula must align to State Core Standards as outlined by the USBOE.

Math

- We use the district-approved Mathematics curriculum like every other elementary school across the district, both Title I and non-Title I schools. All curricula must align to State Core Standards as outlined by the USBOE.

Computers & Technology

- Each classroom is equipped with current instructional technology to facilitate student learning, including Chromebooks, document cameras, and interactive whiteboards.
- All Grade levels K-5 have a one-to-one device ratio.
- Teachers and staff receive ongoing training in technology as part of our professional development plan.
- All of our Kindergarten - 2nd grade as well as all ESL students in 3rd – 5th grade use a software program called Imagine Learning that provides leveled instruction in language arts on a daily basis.

After School Program

- Legacy has an after school program through a partnership with Boys and Girls Club of America. Students are provided with support for homework and class assignments.

Supplemental Interventions

- Legacy uses the district process to identify gifted students. When students qualify, they are invited to attend our district GTE magnet schools. In addition, we offer a Lego Robotics Club after school during certain times.
